According to the Constitutional Act Concerning the prevention and suppression of corruption, B.E.2018 Section 128, paragraph one, prohibits any government official from receiving property or any other benefit that mayFrom whom is income calculated? In addition to assets or benefits that should be obtained according to laws, rules or regulations issued By virtue of the provisions of the law Except for receiving property or any other benefits by virtue of ethics.

Criteria and amounts specified by the National Anti-Corruption Commission and code of ethics Police officers, 2021, Section 2(2), be honest and honest. Performing duties according to law Office regulations The Royal Thai Police is transparent and does not display behavior that is indicative of illegal exploitation. They are responsible.to human rights duties Be ready to receive audits and accept responsibility. have a good conscience Consider society and item 2(4).Think about public benefits more than personal interests, have public spirit, cooperate, join together, and sacrifice in making benefits.for the public and creating benefits and happiness for society, together with the national reform plan for prevention and Suppress corruption and misconduct (revised edition) determines important reform activities, Activity 5: Development Thai bureaucracy To be transparent and without profit. Goal 1, Section 1.1, have all government agencies announce that they are Agencies where all government officials do not accept gifts and gratuities of any kind. From performing duties (NO Gift Policy)

Therefore, in order to prevent conflict between personal interests and public interests (Confictof Interest) Receiving bribes, gifts, gifts, or any other benefits that affect the performance of the police station's duties.Mueang Satun Province Therefore, guidelines for anti-bribery (Anti-Bribery Policy) and non-acceptance of goods have been established.Gifts, gifts or other benefits (No Gift Policy) from performing duties The details are as follows:

Article 1 This announcement: Definitions

"Commander" means a person who has the authority to command, supervise, monitor and inspect.Police officers under Muang Satun Provincial Police Station

“Bribe” means property or any other benefit given to a person. to induce that person to act or not doing anything in the position Whether it is right or wrong according to duty

“Performing duties” means the actions or performance of duties of government officials in appointed position or has been assigned to perform any duties or to act on behalf of the government in the performance of duties

any one function Both in general and specifically as a police officer as required by law. authority or is carried out in accordance with the powers and duties specified by law to have the powers and duties of the police

"Gifts, presents, or any other benefits that affect the performance of duties" means Property, services, or other benefits that are of value and are provided, including tips. which government officials receive in addition to their salary Income, benefits from government service in normal cases and affecting decisions, approvals, permissions, or anything else in Perform duties in a manner that benefits the giver of gifts in the past or while receiving or while dishonest future

Article 2: Police officers at all levels shall conduct themselves as follows:

1.) Do not ask for directions, give or accept bribes, gifts, presents or any other benefits from

2.) Do not consent or connive with family members giving or receiving bribes, gifts, or or any other benefits to those involved in performing duties

3.) The performance of duties must be based on enforcing the law with fairness, benefit and image The appearance of the police is important. Must not do anything which is a conflict between personal interests and results Public benefits such as receiving gifts or any other benefits that affect the performance of duties, leading government resources Using stolen property for personal gain, disclosing inside information, stealing time government service to do special work, etc.

4.) Reduce the giving or receiving of property or any other benefits in accordance with the principles and ethics The amount specified by the National Anti-Corruption Office By using the method of expression by signing Greeting cards, greeting books, condolence cards or using social media instead of giving things

5.) Do not tolerate, do not tolerate, do not ignore the behavior of accepting bribes and gifts. Gifts or any other benefits from performing duties If you find any violations, please inform the superintendent/station head immediately.

Article 3: Monitoring and inspection measures Give supervisors the authority to supervise, monitor and Examine police officers under your jurisdiction Behave according to this

announcement. In the case of finding an action that violates the announcement This issue must be reported to the Superintendent of Muang Satun Provincial Police Station as soon as possible.
